

POLLINATOR GARDEN / WELCOME NEW FAMILIES



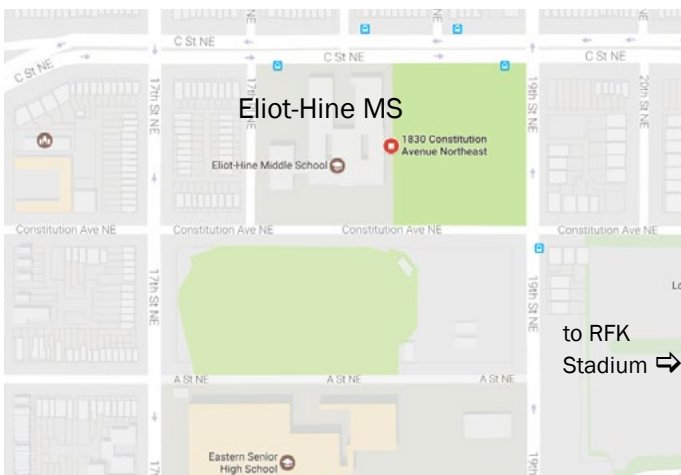
